SUBJECT:

Transfer Case Input Seal Leak

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves replacing the transfer case input gear and seal.

MODELS:

2016 (JK) Jeep Wrangler

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: NAFTA.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or after November 25, 2015 (MDH 1125XX) and on or before August 10, 2016 (MDH 0810XX) equipped with a 4:1 Rock-Trac Hd Part Time 4wd Sys Transfer Case (Sales Code DHW).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may experience red fluid weeping from under their vehicle and showing up on the ground. Customers may also describe transfer case noise coming from the vehicle while in four wheel drive. These issues are typically observed at less than one month in service at an average of 1,097 km (682 mi).

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the repair.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

CAUTION: If the input gear cap plug is dislodged, out of position or loose, do not attempt to fix or reinstall the cap plug (Fig. 1). Attempting to fix cap plug will not correct the issue and will result in the issue reoccurring.
