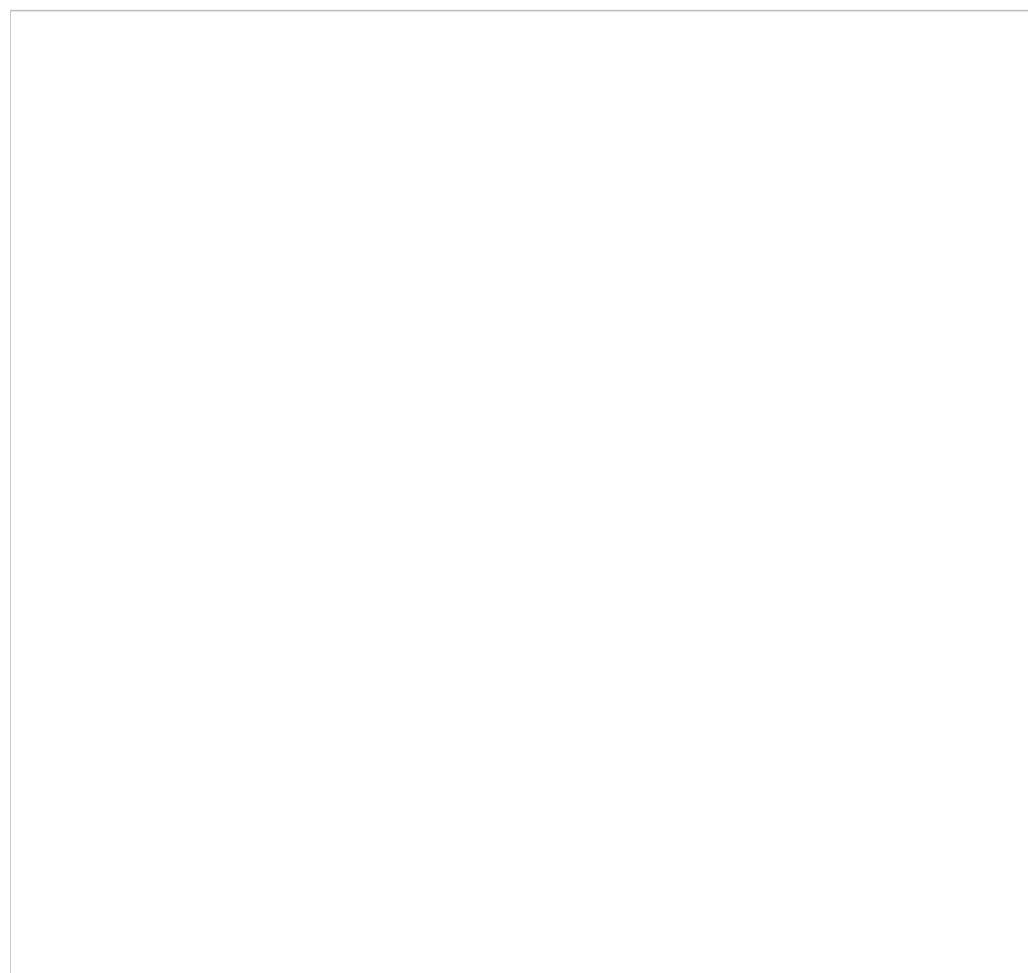

Condition	Some customers may comment that the vehicle has an oil leak from front of vehicle that is visible on the garage floor or driveway. Upon inspection the technician may find an oil leak that is coming from between the oil cooler and oil pan.					
Cause	This condition may be caused by inadequately torqued bolts from the oil cooler to oil pan.					

Correction:

Ensure fasteners (1) that mount the oil cooler to the oil pan are properly torqued. (see below)



The proper torque is 10Nm (89 lb in).

After verifying proper torque clean area and retest.

Engine dye may be helpful to determine source of leak.

When repair is complete document findings on repair order.

NOTE: This is a temporary fix the permanent service fix is under investigation.
