An issue has been identified on certain vehicles within the listed Affected Vehicle Range where the front floor console left and right sliding armrests have free play back and forth.

ACTION:

Retailers are required to **HOLD** affected new vehicles that are within your control and refrain from releasing the vehicles for **new vehicle sale** pending completion of the Workshop Procedure detailed in this Technical Bulletin. Unsold vehicles should have this performed as part of the Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) process but **must** have it completed prior to vehicle handover to the customer.

Affected vehicles already in the hands of customers should be updated at the next available opportunity.






Slide both floor console stowage compartment lids to the forward position.


Remove both floor console stowage compartment lids.






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Apply glue to the 4 rubber buffers.



Install the 4 rubber buffers into the front end of the sliding arms.

Visually inspect the floor console stowage compartment lids.

- If the gap hider is installed correctly (), go to Step 7.
- If the gap hider is not installed correctly (X), push the gap hider into its correct location.
 - \blacksquare Once the gap hider is installed correctly (\checkmark), go to Step 7.
- 7 Reverse Steps 1-3 to install the floor console stowage compartment lids.
