### INTRODUCTION:

This Service Information bulletin announces changes made to Subaru Genuine Brake Fluid.

### PRODUCTION CHANGE INFORMATION:

The new brake fluid was incorporated into production during January 2018.

### PART INFORMATION:

The part number for Subaru Genuine Brake Fluid has changed from SOA868V9220 to **SOA868V9221**.

### NOTES:

- The new fluid bottle can easily be identified by the new label as shown below.
- The new fluid has a yellowish color to it as opposed to a “clear” color.
- Both the new and old fluids are completely compatible with each other and can be mixed.
- Both fluids meet DOT 3 specifications.
- Both fluids are for use in hydraulic brake and clutch systems.
