<b>Involved Region or Country</b>	North America and N.A. Export Regions
<b>Additional Options (RPOs)</b>	Excluding Auto Control High Beam (RPO TQ5)
<b>Condition</b>	Some customers may comment that the Intellibeam/Auto high beam function is inoperable when pushing the button on the turn signal switch.
<b>Cause</b>	This condition can be caused by the incorrect turn signal switch being assembled on the vehicle due to an engineering release concern. <b>Note:</b> This impacts Denali only without the Driver Alert Package, Denali vehicles without TQ5 option.
<b>Correction</b>	Replace the turn signal switch with the correct part, and inform the customer that their vehicle is not equipped with the Auto high beam feature.

### Service Procedure

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, replace the turn signal switch with the correct part. Refer to *Turn Signal Switch Replacement* in SI.

### Parts Information

For the correct part number, refer to the latest part number listed in the parts catalog with the VIN filter on.
