Condition	<p>The new ZR1 is available in 2 aerodynamic configurations. The base configuration features a low mounted rear wing and the ZTK configuration features a high mounted large wing.</p> <p>These components should never be interchanged. In other words, even if the customer requests it, do not install the low wing on a car with ZTK and do not install a high wing on a car without ZTK.</p> <p>GM does not approve swapping the rear wing spoiler with any spoiler other than the one that the vehicle was built with. You can confirm the correct spoiler that came with the vehicle by searching the vehicle's build RPOs.</p>

Service Procedure

No alterations to the rear wing spoiler should be performed.

GM does not recommend driving the ZR1 with any of the rear spoilers removed from the vehicle. Removing the rear spoiler can affect the vehicle's handling at higher speeds.

The vehicle's handling was designed specifically for the aero components the vehicle was produced with. Changing the aero components has an effect on the vehicle's handling and should not be altered.
