## 2014-2017 ROGUE AND ROGUE HYBRID; SQUEAK OR RATTLE FROM FRONT DOOR FINISHER

This bulletin has been amended. The PARTS INFORMATION and CLAIMS INFORMATION sections have changed. No other changes have been made. Please discard all previous versions of this bulletin.

APPLIED VEHICLES:

2017 Rogue Hybrid (T32) 2014-2017 Rogue (T32) USA built – first 3 characters of the VIN are **5N1**... Korea built – first 3 characters of the VIN are **KNM**...

NOTE: Does not apply to Japan built Rogue (VIN starting with JN8...)

## IF YOU CONFIRM

While driving, a squeak noise is heard from either front door finisher in the areas shown in Figure 1,

## AND

The noise stops when the area is pressed,

## AND

The VIN begins with 5N1.

## OR

The VIN begins with KNM and was built before KNMAT2M(\*\*)GP 605885 // October 1, 2015.

## AND/OR

A rattle noise is heard when either front door outside handle is operated,

## AND

The VIN begins with 5N1 and was built before 5N1AT2M(\*\*)HC 830035 // May 1, 2017.

## ACTION

- If applicable, apply felt tape to repair front door finisher squeak noise. See page 2.
- If applicable, apply felt tape to repair front door handle noise. See page 4.

**IMPORTANT:** The purpose of **ACTION** (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the <u>entire</u> **SERVICE PROCEDURE** as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.



#### SERVICE PROCEDURE

#### **Repair Front Door Finisher Squeak Noise**

Perform the following procedure ONLY if applicable (see page 1).

- 1. Remove the front door finisher.
  - Refer to the Electronic Service Manual (ESM), section **INT-Interior**, for removal instructions.
  - Ensure proper handling of door trim panel to prevent damage on any surfaces.
- 2. Cut 4 strips of felt tape (part # J-50397-5) to the following lengths:
  - 1 piece to 130 mm.
  - 1 piece to 120 mm.
  - 1 piece to 50 mm.
  - 1 piece to 30 mm.

#### NOTE:

- > Felt tape can be found in Squeak and Rattle Kit J-50397.
- > 4 strips of felt tape will be required per front door finisher.

3. Apply felt tape to the areas indicated in Figures 2, 3, and 4.



- 4. Reinstall the front door finisher.
  - Refer to the ESM, section **INT-Interior**, for installation instructions.
- 5. Confirm the squeak noise is no longer occurring.

#### **Repair Front Door Handle Rattle Noise**

Perform the following procedure ONLY if applicable (see page 1).

- 1. Remove the front door finisher.
  - Refer to the ESM, section INT-Interior, for removal and reinstallation instructions.
  - Ensure proper handling of door trim panel to prevent damage on any surfaces.
- 2. Cut 4 strips of felt tape (part # J-50397-5) to **25 mm**.

### NOTE:

- > Felt tape can be found in Squeak and Rattle Kit J-50397.
- > 4 pieces of felt tape will be required per front door.
- 3. Apply 2 piece of felt tape, side by side, to the outside door handle cable in the 2 locations where it contacts the harness. See the areas indicated in Figure 5.



- 4. Reinstall the front door finisher.
  - Refer to the ESM, section **INT-Interior**, for installation instructions.
- 5. Confirm the rattle noise is no longer occurring.
