#### Workshop findings:

One or more of the following DTCs are stored in the engine control module (ECM), J623 (address word 0001):

- DTC P029900 (below charge pressure control limit)
- DTC P023400 (charge pressure control limit exceeded)

The diameter of waste gate adjustment control line (07K145675C) is constricted.

## **Technical Background**

Waste gate adjustment control line 07K145675C has become soft and its diameter constricted (Figure 1).
