1. Raise the vehicle hood and locate the oil fill cap installed on the driver side of the engine.

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5019920

Remove the existing fill cap (marked SAE 5W-30) and install the new service fill cap with the correct SAE 0W-40 specification printed on top.

Dealer Responsibility
