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
- 1. Raise and support the vehicle. Refer to Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle in SI.
- 2. Remove the right front wheel and tire assembly.

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- 3. Inspect for the installation of the engine front splash shield-right side (front).
 - If the engine front splash shield right side (front) is installed, no further action required. Install the wheel and tire
 assembly and lower the vehicle.



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- If the engine front splash shield right side (front) is NOT installed, inspect the starter and ground ring terminals for any corrosion as shown above. Clean as required and install the engine front splash shield right side (front). Refer to Engine Front Splash Shield Replacement Right Side (Front) in SI.
- 4. Install the wheel and tire assembly and lower the vehicle.

Dealer Responsibility

Whenever a vehicle subject to this service update enters your vehicle inventory, or is in your facility for service in the future, and the vehicle is still covered under the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, you must take the steps necessary to be sure the service update correction has been made before selling or releasing the vehicle.

All new, used, GM Certified Used, courtesy transportation vehicles, dealer shuttle vehicles, etc. in dealers' possession and subject to this bulletin <u>must</u> be held and inspected/repaired per the service procedure of this bulletin <u>before</u> customers take possession of these vehicles. Upon submitting an accepted/paid warranty transaction in the Global Warranty Management (GWM) system, the vehicle can be re-certified for sale within the CPOIS system, or once again be used in the CTP program.
