INTRODUCTION:

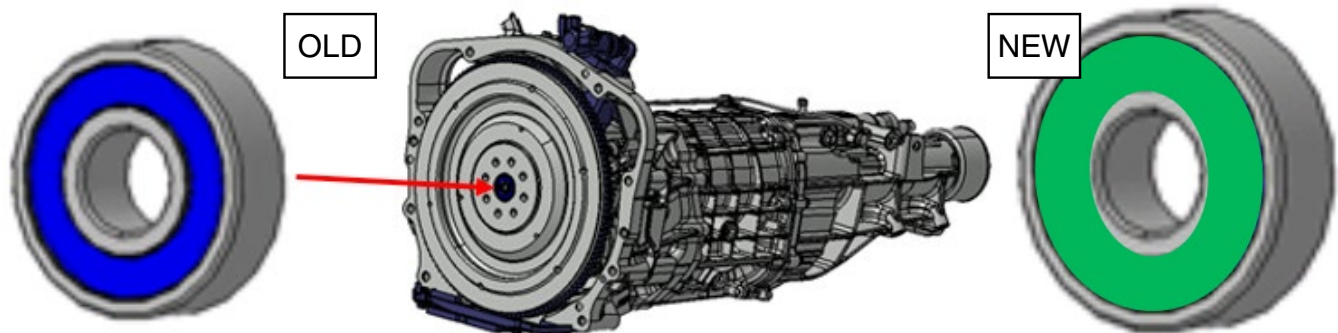
