

On some vehicles, one or more roof carrier brackets (A) may be installed in reverse (with arrows (B) facing outward). In this case, accessories, such as a roof carrier cannot be installed. Even if the accessory installation was possible, it may cause loose fitting, water leaks or other concerns.

- 2. If any roof carrier bracket(s) are not installed correctly, remove the affected bracket(s) and install new ones in the correct direction, according to the ROOF CARRIER BRACKET REMOVAL/INSTALLATION instructions.

NOTE: All four (4) roof carrier brackets must be installed so the arrows face inward.

3. Verify the repair.


