
#### APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

2014-2016 Mazda6

2017 Mazda6 vehicles with VINs lower than JM1GJ\*\*\*\*\*153693 (produced before Dec. 5, 2017)

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Some vehicles may exhibit wind noise at rear door quarter glass when driven at high speeds. This is caused by air leakage from the gap between rear sash molding, rear door glass run channel, rear door glass guide and rear door quarter glass guide.



To eliminate this concern, the following items have been added or changed:

- A rubber seal on rear door quarter glass guide has been extended.
- A rubber seal has been added to rear door glass guide.
- The shape of rear door glass run channel has been changed.


Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Replace the rear door quarter glass guide (1), rear door glass guide (2), and the rear door glass run channel (3) at affected side(s) with modified ones according to the instructions on MGSS (REAR DOOR QUARTER GLASS REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).



3. Verify repair.
