## Content

<u>Issue:</u> A Customer may report their steering column does not move when trying to adjust in an up/down or in/out movement.

## Cause:

- 1. Connector issue between electrical harness and steering column motors.
- 2. Steering column lost position, which result in no steering column movement in either, or both directions.

## Action:

- 1. Disconnect and reconnect both connectors located on column adjustments motors, underneath the column, as shown in the attachment. Ensure an audible click is heard when reconnecting, thus ensuring correct latching of the harness connectors into the female part located on the motors. Apply a slight pull force over check on the male harness connector, to ensure a robust connection is made
- 2. Clear any DTC's.
- 3. Run the steering column calibration routine using the approved diagnostic equipment ensuring correct adjustment function.
- 4. Adjust the column in all directions to confirm full functionality.
