Warning: To avoid being burned, do not remove the radiator cap or surge tank cap while the engine is hot. The cooling system will release scalding fluid and steam under pressure if radiator cap or surge tank cap is removed while the engine and radiator are still hot.

1. Raise and support the vehicle. Refer to Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle in SI.

- 2. Place a drain pan under the radiator drain cock.
- 3. Install a suitable length of hose to the radiator drain cock nipple and route the hose to allow free drain of coolant.
- 4. Open the radiator drain cock.
- 5. Using the chart below, drain the appropriate amount of coolant.
- 6. Close the radiator drain cock and remove hose.

- 8. Open the hood and install fender covers.
- 9. Remove the radiator surge tank cap.

- 11. Install the radiator surge cap.
- 12. Remove the fender covers and close hood.
