
2017 CX-5 vehicles with VINs lower than JM3KF\*\*\*\*\*133707 (produced before April 11, 2017)

#### DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may have a broken trunk board (2) strap (1). This may be caused by insufficient strap cover strength. To eliminate this concern, the material of the strap cover has been changed to increase the strength.

### **BROKEN COVER**




Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

## **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

- 1. Verify the customer concern.
- 2. Replace the strap (1), cover (2) and bolt (3) with new ones.

**NOTE:** If the old bolt is reused, remove the old locking agent from the threads and apply new thread locking agent.

3. Verify the repair.
