## 40 Front shock absorber cap, cracking noises/spring jumps when steering

### Customer states:

- Cracking noises/spring jumps when steering or when maneuvering.
- The noise can be reproduced when at least 2 people are in the vehicle and the steering wheel is just before the right/left stop.

## Technical Background

The buffer stop for shock absorber (Figure 1, 1) can cause noises if it touches the front shock absorber cap (Figure 1, 2).

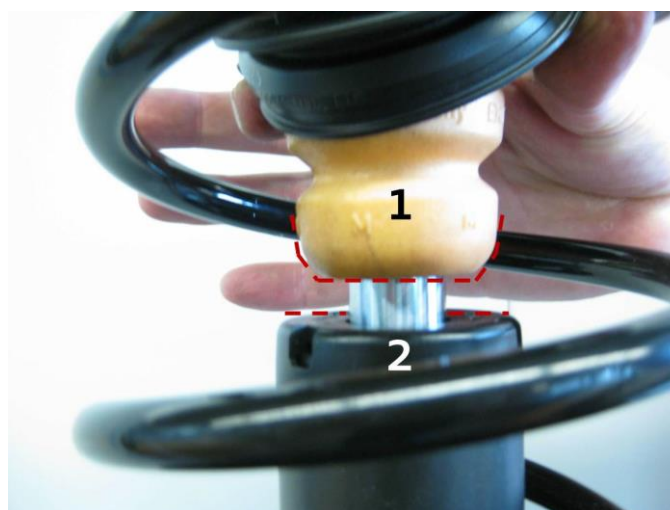

## Service

Lightly lubricate the contact surface (red dotted line) between buffer stop for shock absorber (Figure 1, 1) and front shock absorber cap (Figure 1, 2) with 5 grams of silicon grease G 000 405 A2 per side.



**Figure 1.** Shock absorber and buffer stop.



**Tip:** Check the protective sleeve of the front shock absorber for correct fit, they should turn easily in the axial deep-groove ball bearing/sleeve bearing.
