

STATIONARY CLIMATE CONTROL NOT POSSIBLE WHEN SET FOR DEPARTURE TIME BETWEEN 0:00 AND 0:30 TIME RANGE.

MODEL

F30 PHEV (330e			
iPerformance)	I01 (I3)		l15 (l8)

SITUATION

The programmed stationary climate control ventilation function does not switch on when the departure time is set between 0:00 and 0:30 time range (With the vehicle time setting set to 24 hour).

CAUSE

The software of the integrated automatic heating/air conditioning system.

CORRECTION

Please advise the customer that setting a departure time for the stationary climate control in **the 0:00 to 0:30** range (with the vehicle time setting of 24hour) is not possible via the iDrive on the vehicle.

The customer may however set departure time in the range between 00:31 and 23:59.

Alternatively It is possible to set "any" departure time even between 0:00 - 0:30 time range when using the BMW Connected App (BMW I Remote App).

There is therefore no further action required other than informing the customer.

PROCEDURE

Please advise the customer that setting a departure time for the stationary climate control from 0:00 to 0:30 is not possible via the iDrive on the vehicle.

Additional information with regard to the correction or work around for setting departure time in the 0:00 to 0:30 time range in special cases:

- If the desired departure time is 0:00 => Set departure to 23:50
 - o Due to post-conditioning, the stationary climate control runs until 0:04 (function end = departure time + 14 minutes)
- If the desired departure time is 0:15 => Set departure to 23:59
 - o Due to post-conditioning, the stationary climate control runs until 0:13 (function end = departure time + 14 minutes)
