The hood interior release lever may be inoperative and not release the hood.

This may be caused by the hood release cable not being the correct length.

- Verify hood release operation.
  - If the hood interior release lever does operate the hood latches and the hood can be opened, go to Step 5.
  - If the hood interior release lever does not operate the hood latches and the hood cannot be opened, go to Step 2.




Remove hood interior release lever from the hood release mechanism.



Release the hood release cable from the hood release mechanism.


- 4 Use a suitable tool to operate the hood release cable to open the hood latches.


Release the hood release cable.






Remove the trim.
