

Renew only a defective rear lamp assembly.

Remove the affected rear lamp assembly (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 417-01:
Exterior Lighting - Removal and Installation - Rear Lamp Assembly).

## CAUTION:

The new rear lamp assembly must have a date stamp of 07/07/2018 or later.



Inspect and record the date stamp on the **new** rear lamp assembly.

Install the new rear lamp assembly (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 417-01: Exterior Lighting - Removal and Installation - Rear Lamp Assembly).
