	Some customers may comment that the power folding mirror(s): - Do not stop at the correct location - Do not move and make a grinding noise - Fold completely forward.
Cause	This concern could be caused by an issue with the mirror head pivot stop/detent.  This concern is more likely to occur if the mirrors are power folded in while going through a car wash.

#### **Correction:**

Perform the reset procedure shown during the October 2018 Emerging Issues show course #10218.10V in "What's Hot For Trucks" segment.

Engineering is working on an updated mirror pivot detent. Until the new design mirrors are available, it is recommend to leave the mirrors deployed while going through a car wash. The pivot detent is less likely to lose index if the mirrors are in the deployed position.

Note: Replacement mirrors currently do NOT have the updated pivot detent design and there is no benefit in replacing the mirror(s) at this time.

When the new mirror design is available this PI will be converted into a bulletin.
