Reason for this Service Bulletin

After a tyre change on V12 Vantage vehicles with Rimstock light weight wheels it is possible that the wheel weight touches the brake caliper. The decreased clearance between the Rimstock light weight wheel and the brake caliper is the cause of this.

The Rimstock wheels which can have this problem are as follows:

- ED23-1007-CA - FRONT WHEEL 19 INCH BLACK SATIN
- ED23-1007-DA - FRONT WHEEL 19 INCH SW SILVER
- ED23-1007-EA - FRONT WHEEL 19 INCH GRAPHITE
- ED23-1007-FA - FRONT WHEEL 19 INCH GLOSS BLACK

Workshop Procedure

1. Remove the wheel and tyre (refer to Workshop Manual procedure 04.04.EC).
2. Remove the wheel weights.
3. Balance the wheel with low-profile wheel weights, no more than 4mm high.
4. Install the wheel and tyre (refer to Workshop Manual procedure 04.04.EC).
5. Do steps 1 thru 4 again for all the wheels with this problem.
