DESCRIPTION:

If steering wheel is off center while driving straight forward, then follow Service below.

The steering wheel is always positioned correctly at the assembly line, but if the steering wheel is removed for various adjustments it may not be reinstalled correctly on the steering column.

SERVICE:

1. Remove driver's airbag according to VIDA (VCC-ID: VCC-502656-1)
2. Remove the screw for steering wheel according to VIDA (VCC-ID: VCC-502279-1)
3. Align the steering wheel to the steering column, follow the markings according to picture TJ 33715.jpg
4. Reinstall all parts according to VIDA (torque screw 60 N)
5. Perform a wheel alignment on front wheels according to VIDA (VCC-ID: VCC-502859-1)
5. Verify repair
