- Audio sounds distorted from door speakers or subwoofer.
- Vehicle is equipped with the Bang and Olufsen sound system.

Technical Background

Software parameter allows speaker to be overpowered, resulting in distortion.

Production Solution

New software in the sound system control module, J525 (address word 0047) addressed the condition.
