## Technical Background

When the sunroof glass body perimeter seal is replaced, the new seal may not compress as easily as the original seal due to the new seal not having break in time. This lack of break in time may lead to unwanted pinch protection activations or other issues.

## Service

After replacement of the sunroof glass body perimeter seal, make all the needed adjustments per the repair information in ELSA and allow the vehicle to sit with the sunroof closed for a period of few hours. If possible, place the vehicle in direct sunlight to aid in the new seal break in process. After the time has elapsed, perform any basic settings as needed and test the sunroof operation.


