

Condition / Concern

When performing a pre-delivery inspection you may find a piece of foam that is surrounded by a cardboard shell that is found in the vehicle during PDI. (See Photos below)





Recommendations / Instructions

This Insert is a spacer that is part of the tire Inflator kit and should be placed between the compressor assembly and the tire sealant canister. This Insert needs to be installed to prevent the damage to the contents of the bag when tightening the hold down for the Inflator kit.



Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
