Issue: Some 2015 Transit vehicles equipped with a 3.2L engine may exhibit an illuminated MIL with DTCs P24A0 and/or P26A0 stored in the powertrain control module (PCM).

Action: Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

- (2). No this article does not apply. Refer to the Powertrain Controls/Emissions Diagnosis (PC/ED) Manual for normal diagnostics.
- 2. Replace the fuel vaporizer system glow plug. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM) Section 309-00C.
