#### Introduction

Some 2010 – 2015 model year RX450h vehicles may exhibit a squawk and/or a knocking noise coming from the engine compartment when releasing the brake pedal. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.

#### **APPLICABLE WARRANTY**

- This repair is covered under the Lexus Basic Warranty. This warranty is in effect for 48 months or 50,000 miles, whichever occurs first, from the vehicle's in-service date.
- Warranty application is limited to occurrence of the specified condition described in this bulletin.

#### **Repair Procedure**

 Confirm that the vehicle has a squawk and/or knocking noise from the engine compartment when releasing the brake pedal.

Squawk/Knock noise example.

- 2. Is there a squawk/knock noise when releasing the brake pedal?
  - YES Continue to step 3.
  - NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 3. Bleed the brake system.

#### NOTE

Bleed the brakes by following the procedure to bleed the actuator.

Refer to TIS, applicable model and model year Repair Manual:

- 2010 (03/2009 08/2009) / 2010 (08/2009 –) / 2011 / 2012 / 2013 / 2014 / 2015 RX450h: Brake – Brake System – "Brake System (Other): Brake Fluid: Bleeding"
- 4. Is the squawk/knock noise still present AFTER bleeding the brakes?
  - YES Continue to step 5.
  - NO Go to step 6.



# Squawk Noise When Releasing Brake

## Repair Procedure (continued)

- Replace the brake actuator assembly.
  Refer to TIS, applicable model and model year Repair Manual:
  - 2010 (03/2009 08/2009) / 2010 (08/2009 –) / 2011 / 2012 / 2013 / 2014 / 2015 RX450h: Brake – Brake Control/Dynamic Control System – "Brake Control/Dynamic Control Systems: Brake Actuator: Removal"
  - 2010 (03/2009 08/2009) / 2010 (08/2009 –) / 2011 / 2012 / 2013 / 2014 / 2015 RX450h: Brake – Brake Control/Dynamic Control System – "Brake Control/Dynamic Control Systems: Brake Actuator: Installation"
- 6. Confirm normal braking operation and no noise is heard when releasing the brake.
