## Technical Background

After replacing the battery it is necessary to adapt the battery to the vehicle. If the adaptation is not completed, the start/stop function will be inoperative. Additionally, charging system operation may be effected and various DTCs can result.

## Service

Connect a scan tool.

- Go to the test plan tab.
- Go to select self-test.
- Go to Diagnosis-capable systems.
- Go to 0019 - Data Bus On Board Diagnostic Interface.
- Go to Battery Adaptation and attach to the test plan.
- Perform the Battery Adaptation test plan.

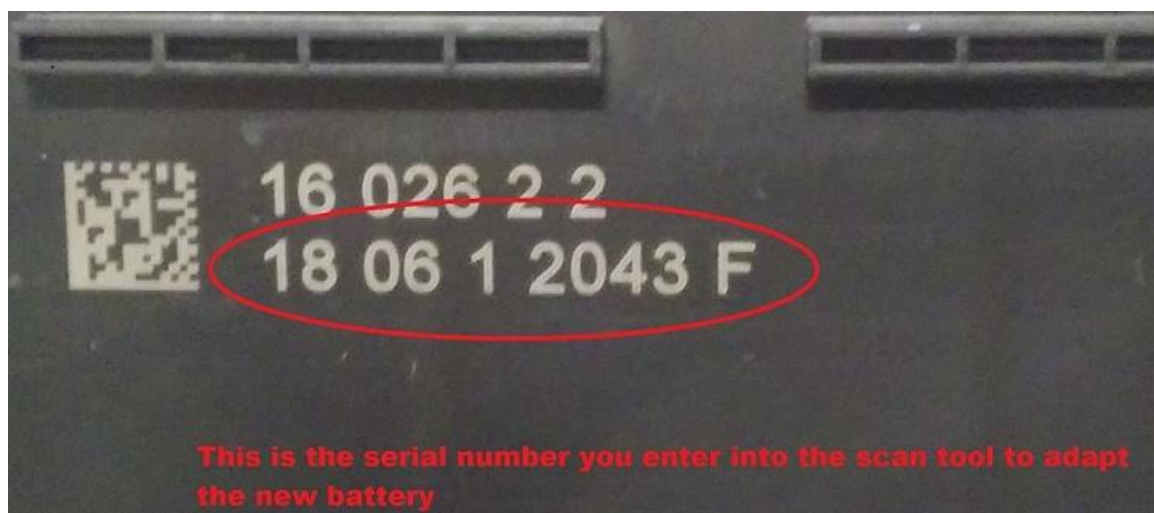


Figure 1: The serial number entered into the scan tool to adapt the new battery.

During the test plan you will be asked for the serial number of the battery (Figure 1).
