Introduction

Peterbilt has determined that certain Model 567/579 vehicles equipped with a VECU may activate frequently when the LVD is enabled.

- The reverse lights may turn on frequently if the vehicle is parked in the reverse gear on vehicles equipped with a manual transmission and the LVD enabled.
 - The dash display may illuminate frequently

Fix-As-Fail

If a customer comes into your dealership and demonstrates the condition above, update the CECU software.

Warranty

Through Standard Warranty, Peterbilt will pay for labor to update the software:
