Condition	Some customers may comment that they are unable to manually adjust the clock. This is typically noticed when time change is necessary for Daylight Saving Time. When entering the Time/Date menu, there is no option for Auto Update. Pressing the Set Time option highlights the option when touched, but does not open the menu to allow manual clock adjustment.		
Cause	The cause of this condition may be that the manual clock adjustments can only occur when the Auto Update feature is disabled. This condition can occur when the clock Auto Update feature was previously enabled and the OnStar® account Terms & Conditions are later declined by the customer without first disabling the Auto Update. Once the system reports to the radio that OnStar Terms & Conditions are declined, the Auto Update option is removed from the Time/Date menu. A software anomaly allows the Auto Update option to remain enabled when the option is removed from the menu, preventing manual clock adjustments from occurring.		
Correction	Disable the Auto Update feature in the radio Time/Date menu following the Service Procedure below.		

Service Procedure

Note: If OnStar account Terms and Conditions are declined, the Auto Update option is removed from the Time/Date menu. A software anomaly allows the Auto Update option to remain enabled when the option is removed from the menu, preventing manual clock adjustments from occurring.

Note: Do NOT replace any components for this condition. This condition ONLY applies to vehicles with IOR radio and an OnStar account with Terms & Conditions declined. If the vehicle has an active OnStar subscription, this Bulletin does NOT apply.

- 1. With ignition OFF, open driver side door to wake the radio.
- 2. Remove the fuse associated with the radio for 5 minutes.
- 3. Reinstall the radio fuse.

Note: It is important to perform the following step immediately following the fuse installation. This fuse pull will only temporarily display the clock Auto Update feature in the Time/Date menu until the OnStar module again reports to the radio that Terms & Conditions were declined.

- 4. Turn ignition ON and enter the Radio Settings, Time/Date menu.
- 5. Disable the Auto Update option.



6. Set the clock to the proper time.
