Overview

Unfortunately, a much higher than expected demand for the equipment option "Weissach package" (I-no. P70 or 808) has resulted in supply bottlenecks for our supplier for magnesium wheels in certain colors (Platinum silky gloss OB5, Black silky gloss JE1, Brilliant silver 8Z8, Silver 346).

As a result, the 911 GT2 RS can currently only be delivered with aluminum wheels of the same size.

This supply bottleneck does not affect magnesium wheels in white gold metallic.

The aluminum wheels removed during retrofitting will be given to the customer free of charge. Please inform customers about this during vehicle handover.
