WJ89 Campaign - Changing Vehicle Order in the Instrument Cluster

Overview

Due to a process error, the control number SP7 for the software variant of the PDK control unit was not stored in the vehicle order on the affected vehicles.

When the PDK control unit is programmed again using the PIWIS Tester, the wrong software variant will be written into the control unit because the control number is not stored. When programming is complete, a red error message will be displayed in the instrument cluster due to the fact that the wrong PDK software is assigned and this will prevent the driver from engaging the required gear and driving the vehicle.

To prevent this, the vehicle order must be changed in the instrument cluster by adding the control number SP7.
