SUBJECT **SERVICE PROCEDURE FOR ENGINE OIL LEVEL CHECK**

APPLICABLE MODELS ALL B5, C5, GT, Himalayan

We are asking all of the dealers to check the oil levels in all of the units received prior to test riding. The oil checking procedure is the same for all current models and must be followed accurately to confirm proper oil level. Please refer to procedure below and thanks in advance

This Service Bulletin is to inform you about the procedure for checking oil level.

1. Place vehicle on center stand before checking oil.
2. Start and run motorcycle for three minutes.
3. Turn off motorcycle and wait two minutes
4. Check oil level in sight glass on right hand side cover.
5. Oil should be between minimum and maximum mark.
6. If oil is below minimum mark, add 15w-50* weight oil to bring level between minimum and maximum mark. **(Do not over-fill)**
7. Repeat steps 2-5
8. Oil capacity between minimum and maximum marks is approximately 350ml

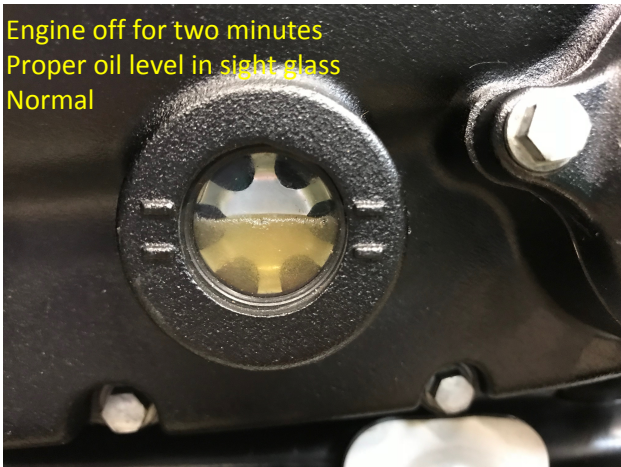
Engine not running

After two minutes (little to no oil in the sight glass)
Normal



Engine off for two minutes
Proper oil level in sight glass
Normal



20w-50* may be used if 15w-50 is not available
