SITUATION:

The rear proximity camera retaining bracket may be loose or adrift, causing the image to be blank on the Touchscreen.

CAUSE:

This may be caused by the camera retaining bracket being incorrectly manufactured.

ACTION:

Should a customer express this concern, follow the Workshop Procedure below.

At step 1 of the installation procedure, install a new bracket.
