	Note: If a device was originally paired while in Demo mode, a similar condition could occur that randomly continues to drop Bluetooth pairing after exiting Demo mode. If the vehicle is not in Demo mode, but it is believed that the device was originally paired while in Demo mode, then delete the device from the radio, delete the radio from the device, and pair the device again.
