Condition

Customer states:

- All driver assistance systems are inoperative.
- A Pre Sense malfunction is displayed in the instrument cluster.
- · The airbag warning lamp is active in the instrument cluster.
- · The airbag functions normally.

Workshop findings:

The following DTCs may be stored in the airbag control module, J234 (address word 0015):

- DTC B101604 (Frt. Pass. Side airbag disabled indicator lamp Faulty).
- DTC B12F104 (Indicator lamp for front passenger airbag Faulty).
- DTC B151304 (Front passenger airbag indicator lamp, text lighting Faulty).

Technical Background

The indicator lamp diagnostics is too sensitive.

Production Solution

New dome light module software addresses the condition.

Service

- 1. If the DTCs are static, please perform a sleep cycle on the vehicle.
- 2. Clear the DTCs and release the vehicle.
- 3. If the DTCs do not clear after a sleep cycle or they come back, please contact TAC for further assistance.
