Technical Background

Message in MFI Refill AdBlue® Engine Start Not Possible. Vehicle will not start. AdBlue® SCR lock reset.

Service

All SCR system faults must be addressed before resetting the AdBlue® light.

For no start and message Engine Start Not Possible:

- Go to control module OBD in ECM.
- Select adaptations channel 56.
- In Hex field change value from 00 00 to 00 19, click on enter, send test value and then apply.

An error may show.

• Click OK and reselect channel. Verify current value changes to 00 19.

Road test vehicle on highway at steady speeds with cruise control on at 50 mph until AdBlue® light resets. Note that it may take up to 50 miles or more before the light will reset.
