Today, March 29, 2019, American Honda is announcing a Product Update for certain 2019 CR-V vehicles to address a concern related to a possible low battery state of charge and/or no start after the vehicle has been parked. **Do an iN VIN inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

American Honda requests that all vehicles be updated prior to sale to ensure customer confidence and satisfaction.

BACKGROUND

The FI-ECU checks for EVAP leaks 5 hours after vehicle shutdown. Due to a programming error, this system may not go back into sleep mode afterwards. As a result, the battery may drain if this condition exists for an extended period of time.

<u>REPAIR</u>

Update the FI-ECU with improved software. Test the battery using your GR8 Diagnostic tester. Depending on the test result, battery replacement may be necessary.

<u>PARTS</u>

Parts are available to complete any necessary repairs.

TOOLS

Software for updating vehicles is available for dealer download at the time of this message. Service bulletin 19-039 has detailed information on the software update procedure. The GR8 Battery Diagnostic Station is part of the dealer required tools and should be in dealer inventory.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service bulletin 19-039, *Product Update: 2019 CR-V PGM-FI Evaporative Emissions Software Update*, has beenposted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of March 29, 2019. It includes software, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda expects to complete initial customer notification by the middle of May 2019.
