CONDITION SUMMARY:

SITUATION:

A 'Driver Intervene' message may be intermittently displayed on the Instrument Cluster and the adaptive cruise control driver intervention system operates when not required, with unexpected braking at low speed. Upon further investigation, no related DTC (Diagnostic Trouble Code) will be stored.

CAUSE:

This may be caused by false operation of the adaptive cruise control driver intervention system due to radar wave reflection within the front bumper cover.

ACTION:

Should a customer express this concern, follow the Workshop Procedure(s) below.





SERVICE INSTRUCTION:


Remove the front bumper (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-19: Bumpers - Front bumper).



Remove the radar bracket.




Only if necessary: remove and discard the existing foam block(s).



Remove the adhesive pads from each new foam block.

Join the new foam blocks together.



Install the new foam blocks.



The foam blocks will expand for 5 minutes when the bag is pierced.


Pierce the foam block bags.



Make sure the foam blocks are installed level with the highlighted hole.



Install the new foam blocks as shown.



Install the radar bracket.

- Torque: 10 Nm
- Install the front bumper (see TOPIx Workshop Manual section 501-19: Bumpers Front bumper).
