#### **DESCRIPTION:**

If the driver quickly and repeatedly turns the steering wheel between its left/right end positions during idle, then a warning message about reduced steering assistance could occur in the drivers information module (DIM) and DTC PSCM-U300094 could be stored.

During frequent steering maneuvering while idling, the charging capacity of the alternator might not be sufficient and the support battery state of charge (SOC) can drop below 9V, which temporarily can reduce the steering assistance for a short moment.

The symptom disappears automatically within 1-2 seconds after driver has finished the parking maneuver.

Affected vehicles are built from chassis number 63425, but also previous vehicles could have this symptom if the vehicle has been updated with new software from July 25th 2018.

#### **SERVICE:**

If the customer has had this warning message and brought the car to a workshop, but the steering system is performing good at the time of the workshop visit, then only inform the customer about this property remark.

There is no need to carry out any fault tracing for this symptom, and there is no need to replace hardware such as steering gear, alternator or support battery.
