Re: Warranty Extension: 2016-17 Accord Daytime Running Lights LEDs

Today, April 10, 2019, American Honda is announcing a Warranty Extension for certain 2016-17 Accord vehicles to address a concern in which the daytime running light (DRL) light emitting diodes (LEDs) may be partially lit or not lit at all. American Honda is extending the new vehicle limited warranty on the DRL LEDs from the original 3 years/36,000 miles to 10 years/unlimited miles from the original date of purchase.

BACKGROUND

Heat from the DRL LEDs, along with clearance variations between the LED and the light guide lens, may damage the lens, causing the LEDs to be partially lit or not lit at all.

REPAIR

Replace the left, right, or both headlights, depending on which DRL LEDs are not working.

PARTS

Parts are available for ordering, however parts are currently in limited supply. At this time, please only place orders for parts for vehicles that exhibit symptoms per bulletin 19-042 or to manage critical customer needs. We expect to have a stable supply of parts by mid-May, 2019.

TOOLS

There are no special tools or equipment required for this repair.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service bulletin 19-042, *Warranty Extension: Daytime Running Lights LEDs*, has been posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of April 10, 2019. It includes parts, repair, and warranty information related to this warranty extension.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda expects to complete customer notification early in July of 2019.

As always, be sure to do an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
