## **Service Procedure**

- 3. Inspect the air filter sealing surface for signs of not contacting the air filter seal (1, 2).
- 1. Inspect the air housing cover for any missing tabs and/or fasteners (1).
- 2. Remove the air filter housing cover and inspect the seal around the air filter (2).

- 4. Inspect the air filter housing cover for dirt and/or debris bypassing the air filter (3).
- 5. Inspect the air cleaner outlet duct for any dirt and/ or debris.
- If dirt and debris has been found bypassing the air filter due to a faulty seal, replace the air filter as necessary.
- If the air filter housing has been found not properly sealing, refer to *Air Cleaner Assembly Replacement* in SI.
