
Condition

Workshop findings:

 When parametrizing the vehicle electrical system control module, J519 (address word 0009) a message is issued by the diagnostic tester, "Invalid characters in the data string when performing the parametrization."



Faster processing.

There are invalid characters in the data string.

Production Solution

New Target Data Container (ZDC) update in the vehicle electrical system control module, J519 (address word 0009) addressed the condition.
