The purpose of this bulletin is to clarify the appropriate use 22" Accessory wheels and tires.

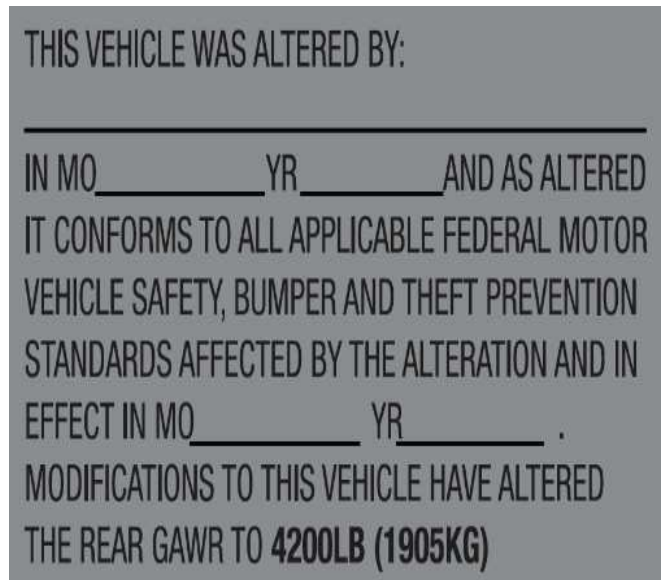
The P285/45R22 GM Accessory tire approved for use with 22" GM Accessory wheels has a load capacity that allows use on vehicles with Rear Gross Axle Weight Ratings (RGAWR) of 4200 lb maximum. If 22" GM Accessory wheels and tires are installed on an unsold vehicle with a RGAWR greater than 4200 lb., it is the Dealer's responsibility to procure and install on the vehicle an Altered Vehicle Certification Label to reduce the certified RGAWR to a maximum of 4200 lb. This label can be found via the following:

US: Via GM as a service part or through the ADIs – Part number 84469617 (10 pack of PN 84469616).

Canada/Mexico/Middle East: Altered Vehicle Label is not available. ACO sales of K2 SUVs are restricted to ZW7 and Z71 suspension packages.

If a dealer has installed 22" GM Accessory wheels and tires on a vehicle with a RGAWR greater than 4200 lb., and that vehicle has subsequently been sold, it is the dealer's responsibility to inform the customer that the effective RGAWR is now 4200 lb., and to provide the customer with an appropriate Altered Vehicle Certification Label (see below).

See approved usage chart listed below for clarification on vehicle model/option combinations that have a RGAWR greater than 4200 lb., and thus require the Altered Vehicle Certification Label with a revised RGAWR of 4200 lb.

Dealers installing GM Accessory wheels and tires on vehicles should call the GM Techline Customer Support Center (TCSC) to:

1. Confirm approved usage of these parts on the specific VIN in question
2. Request any required electronic module re-calibrations
3. Confirm whether an Altered Vehicle Certification Label is required for the specific VIN

Dealers should fill out the dealership name and month and year of alteration. The label should be affixed adjacent to the vehicle certification label, in a manner that does not obscure the vehicle certification label and that is easily visible and legible to the customer.
