#### Cause:

Potential iPhone software issue.

#### Remedy:

Power the affected iPhone off and on again (i.e. hold the side button until the slider appears, slide icon to the right)

If restarting does not remedy the complaint, the customer should carry out the following steps:

- 1.) Perform iPhone backup via iCloud
- 2.) Reset smartphone and configure as new smartphone (Settings -> General -> Reset -> Erase all Content and Settings)
- 3.) If the newly configured smartphone does not experience the complaint, restore the smartphone data from backup

If issue still occurs after these measures please open a PTSS case with the following information:

- initial quick test and Audio 20 control unit log (ensure Audio 20 software is up-to-date)
- iPhone model and software level
