This PI was superseded to update Model Years Please discard PIT5205A.

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition / Concern

Customers may comment that the blower speed knob only goes to 8 with less than expected high blower speed air flow. Upon dealer diagnostic there is no DTC's found and when compared to a like vehicle with blower speed set to 8 the sound is more audible and air flow noticeably higher. This condition is normal when the ECO button is turned on.

NOTE: Vehicles with a Manual HVAC (RPO C67) system will not have reduced blower speed when the ECO button is on.

Recommendations / Instructions

Do NOT replace any parts for this concern.

Turn the ECO button Off and On at different blower speed settings 6 through 8 and note the change in the audible sound and air flow. This is a new enhancement to improve fuel economy when the ECO button is turned on.
