Effective Sunday, May 19th GM has temporarily removed radio software programming from TIS2Web for the above listed vehicles while we work on a solution. The related TSB: *19-NA-047 Radio Software Version V803 Over-the-Air Update* will also be suspended during this time. Normal programming of calibration files is unaffected.

At this time, do not attempt to update radio software until new software can be loaded to TIS2Web. Attempts to download software via TIS2Web will be stopped with the following message:

*"USB programming of this controller is not supported at this time. Consult Preliminary Information (*PIC6365*) for details.*"

Do NOT contact GM Techline Customer Support Center (TCSC) or GM Technical Assistance Center (TAC) for this TIS2Web message.

Note: Do NOT replace a radio to get a software update. The radio will NOT have the latest software release available and could exhibit known issues of the software level that is pre-installed on it.

If diagnosis of a radio malfunction leads to radio replacement on the above listed vehicles be aware that the replacement radio will be provided with an older software version pre-installed. Radio calibration programming

(Radio Programming selection in TIS2Web) of the replacement radio is still required.
