


Breather Hose and Vacuum Pipe and Hose Assembly Replacement Procedure

REMOVAL


1) Remove the engine cover.




2) Remove the breather hose.




3) Remove the air intake pipe. Loosen the hose clamps on both ends, then remove the 2 bolts.




4) Remove the air intake hose.




5) Remove the harness clip.




6) Remove the vacuum pipe and hose assembly.









7-b) Attach the new vacuum pipe and hose assembly (p/n 1632A454).



8) Attach the harness clip.




9) Attach the air intake hose.




10) Attach the air intake pipe.


Tighten the clamps, then reinstall and tighten the 2 bolts.




11) Attach the hose protector (p/n 1035B467) to the breather hose (p/n 1035B477) as shown.




12) Attach the breather hose (p/n 1035B477) with protector attached.
