- The parking brake has fault codes set for calibration or adjustment
- The parking brake is making noise

Technical Background

Parking brake shoes were manufactured that were too long on one end. This resulted in not enough clearance for the shoe. A visible gap will exist with the new improved shoe, as seen in the photo on the right.

Replace the parking brake shoes with new shoes, Part Number 971.698.533.C Parts stock was purged earlier last year. All parts in stock are known good parts.

If the parking brake actuator has been damaged, replace it as well.
